WHAT YOU'LL NEED

make sure you've got these ready when is time to sign the contract)

➤ a valid ID document and a boating license (when required)

PLEASE NOTE: All documents must be original and valid. Photocopies, photos, or expired documents will not be accepted, and the rental will be denied.

➤ a security deposit for the required amount

PLEASE NOTE: are accepted cash or credit card, are NOT acceptend debit and prepaid card

➤ active phone numer and availability

ATTENZIONE: You must provide an active phone number and keep it with you on board.

Please remain reachable and check your phone regularly.

If we cannot reach you in case of emergency, we may need to intervene or contact authorities.

GENERAL SAILING REGULATIONS

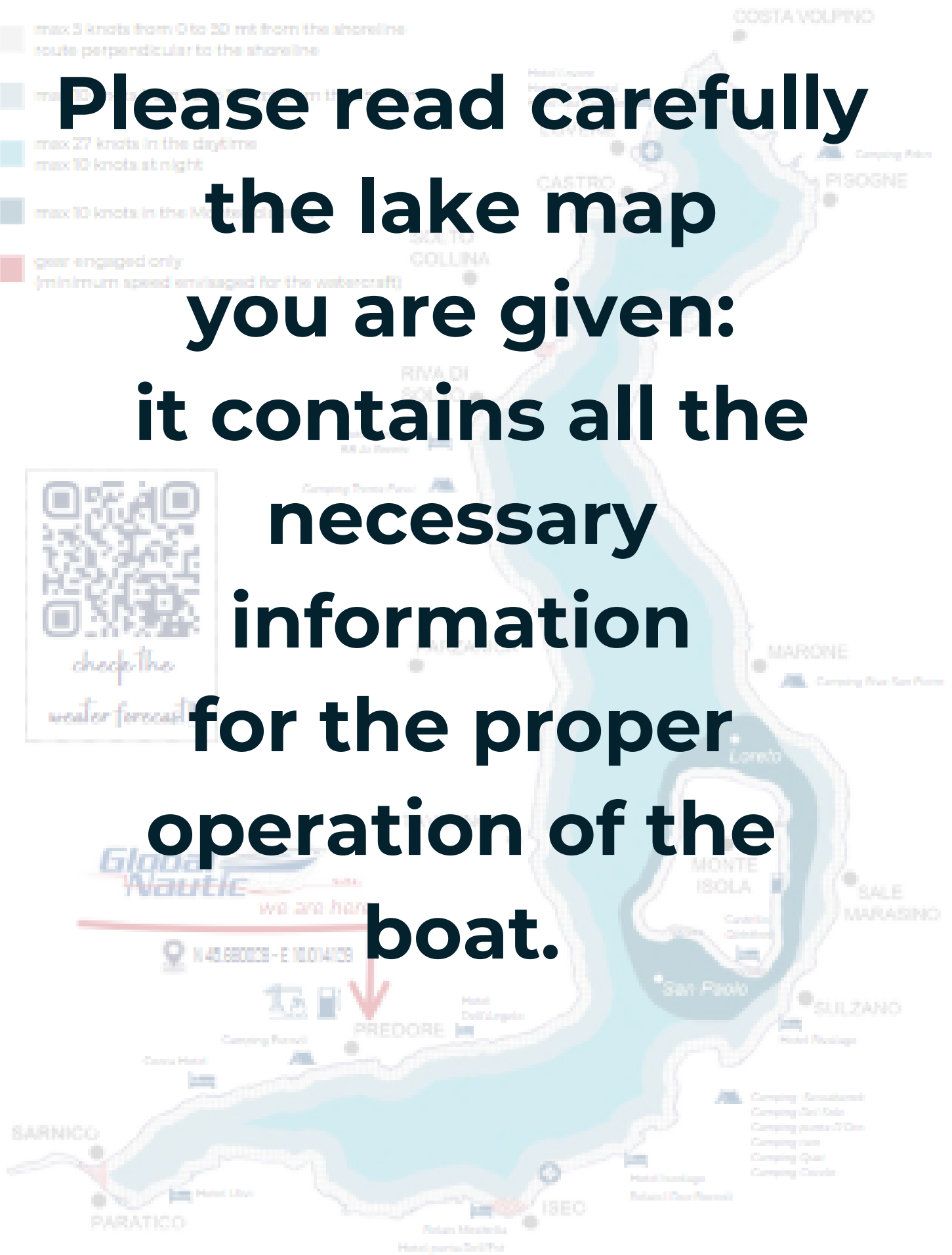
Speed limits:

- max 5 knots from 0 to 50 mt from the shoreline
route perpendicular to the shoreline
- max 10 knots from 50 to 100 mt from the shoreline
- max 27 knots in the daytime
max 10 knots at night
- max 10 knots in the Montebello area
- gear engaged only
(minimum speed envisaged for the watercraft)

Pay close attention, and don't

It's very important to check for any existing damage on the boat and report it to the staff before heading out

(check the edges, sides, propeller, and engine cover!)



Upon return, all boats will be inspected.

If any damage is found, it will be reported and charged up to the amount of the deposit.

The driver is also responsible for the loss or damage due to improper use of:

- the boat's document



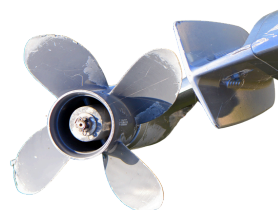
- onboard equipment (lifejackets, fenders, anchor, etc.)



- electronic devices (VHF, fishfinder, etc.)



- components (cusho, suntop, propeller, etc.)

do not carry more passengers than permitted



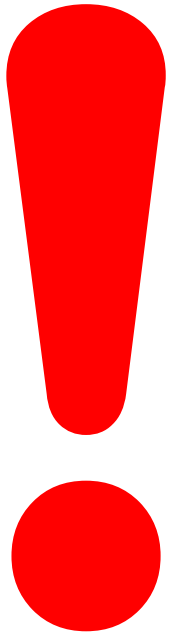
do not operate the boat in a dangerous way

MOORING IS A DELICATE MANEUVER



Mooring is one of the most delicate maneuvers when handling a boat. If you don't have at least basic experience, we strongly advise against attempting it on your own, especially in windy conditions, strong currents, or crowded harbors. Incorrect mooring can cause damage to the boat (hull, propeller, fenders, etc.) or to other nearby vessels. In case of damage, repair costs will be charged to the renter, as stated in the rental agreement.
